

Expectations and Prohibitions in Different Environments:

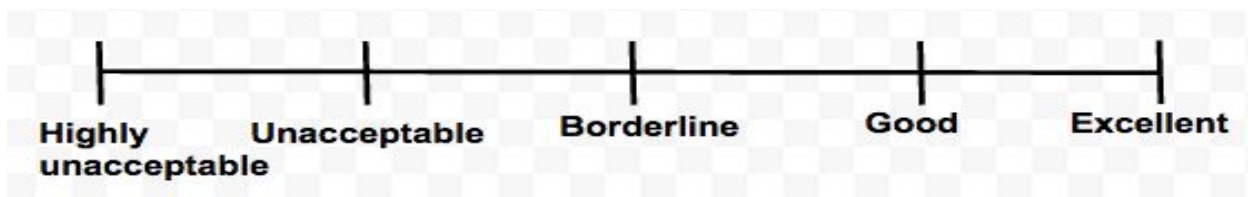
There are a range of possible ways to behave in any environment. Let's talk about what it means to meet the expectations of some different settings using the following self-assessment rating scale:
